Entry Information

- 1. Every entry at this show shall constitute an agreement that the person making it, owner, lessee, trainer, manager, agent, coach, rider and the horse shall be subject to the Horse Protection Act, the bylaws and the rules of the association, and the local rules of the show.
- 2. All entries must be signed by the owner or authorized agent and accompanied by entry fees. Failure to sign entry form may constitute a fine of \$50.00. Parents or guardians must sign entry for any junior exhibitor, 17 & under as of December 31, 2017.
- 3. Entries must be postmarked by the closing date of September 9, 2017 or late fees will apply (see entry form for details of late fees). Your blank, signed check on file in the show office will satisfy this requirement. (Make checks payable to WIWHA). PLEASE DO NOT SEND CHECKS IN THE MAIL.
- 4. The Show office will require a copy of both sides of your horse's papers or a copy of a lease agreement or purchase agreement to be kept by the office for permanent record. Please note that the USDA may ask you for a copy of your horse's papers, so make sure you bring them with you.
- 5. All exhibitors must have a WIWHA Amateur or Youth card to show. Please have all forms filled out and make your check payable to WIWHA. THIS WILL BE ENFORCED!
- 6. All participating trainers must present cards from NWWHTA or they must pay a non-member fee of \$25.00 for a guest card. A list of paid members will be given to the show secretary to ensure compliance.
- 7. The Trainer of the horse must sign all entries. If you do your own training, you must sign as Trainer.
- 8. Please list all riders for each horse on the entry form. If additional room is needed, please write it on a separate sheet and staple it to the entry form.
- 9. The listed stall and tack room fee covers Friday through Sunday afternoon. Early arrivals are not recommended, but if necessary, please contact the fairgrounds office –Micheal 360-397-2300. You will need to pay the fairgrounds ahead of time by credit card. \$19.00 per stall for every extra day. You will need to arrive between 9 a.m. and 4 p.m. so your stall can be unlocked. Please indicate your arrival date on the entry form.
- 10. All riders 13 years of age and under are <u>required</u> to wear protective helmets whenever riding and/or showing on the horse show grounds.
- 11. Persons failing to pay their bill at the show will be charged a \$30.00 service fee. If accounts are not settled after billing, they will be turned over to WIWHA for collection and suspensions may apply.
- 12. A \$30.00 service fee plus any added bank charges will be added to all NSF checks. If accounts are not settled after billing, they will be turned over to WIWHA foe collection and suspensions may apply.
- 13. To receive a Pre-Entry refund, a copy of a Veterinarian's certificate will be required and should be filed with the horse show Secretary.
- 14. Working out of trailers is permitted for the day. You will, however, be charged a grounds fee of \$15 per horse, per day. The facility requires that clean up your working area or you will be charged a \$50.00 clean up fee. If staying overnight, you must purchase a stall.
- 15. No tripods will be allowed in the show arena or stands while the show is in progress.
- 16. Additional shavings may be purchased at the show office at a cost of \$12.00/bale. WIWHA reserves the right to change the prices listed above.
- 17. All classes will be \$16.00

Class Information

- 1. All classes will be conducted by the rules of the WIWHA Rulebook which will be available at the show office. All
- 2. TWHBEA Versatility Rule Book will prevail in all TWH Versatility Classes.
- 3. Management has the right to cancel or combine any class with less than three entries.
- 4. All classes must be entered before the session in which the class takes place. If you add a class at the DQP station, you will be assessed a \$5.00 late entry fee in addition to the class entry fee.
- 5. When classes are entered and the horse does not go into the class, the class must be paid for unless the class is canceled or a scratch slip is filled out at the show office before the session of the class has started. No refund will be issued when the horse is excused by the DQP.
- 6. Gate holds (3-minute maximum) will be granted for just cause upon notification of the Paddock Manager.
- 7. To qualify for performance championship classes, horses must have entered and been judged in a two gait class for a two gait championship, or a three gait class for a three gait championship. Youth riders must show in a youth preliminary class to qualify for a youth championship class.
- 8. Country pleasure horses must abide by the flat shod rules in TWH Pleasure classes.
- 9. Time-outs may be granted by the judge when the exhibitor pulls into the center of the arena. Time-outs will be granted for replacement of shoes, replacement of broken equipment, or in other instances where the judge finds valid reason. An exhibitor may be excused from the ring by pulling into the center of the arena and obtaining permission from the judge to be excused.
- 10. Although precautions will be taken to protect property and exhibitors, WIWHA, WIWHA Show & Futurity, Show Committee, and Clark County Fairgrounds will not be responsible for any articles that are lost, destroyed or stolen, the show and/or management will not be liable for any injury sustained in any way to exhibitors, employees or spectators. The warm up arena is a restricted area and as such, is <u>not open to visitors</u>. You must be a trainer, rider or groom to be in the area.
- 11. Management reserves the right to refuse, accept conditionally, to cancel entries, disqualify exhibitors, prohibit exhibition of entries and cancel premiums without claims for damage. Poor Sportsman like conduct will not be tolerated; management has the right to ask anyone who behaves badly to leave the horse show and go home.
- 12. Year End High Points: To obtain Year End High Points, you must be a member of the Tennessee Walking Horse Exhibitors Association of Washington (TWHBEA of WA).
- 13. Prizes: Ribbons will be awarded to 1st through 5th place in all classes. First Place will receive a nice trophy
- 14. A request for added classes may be considered by the show management. Added classes will follow the last class on Saturday night in the order they are received. Added classes must be sponsored in advance and have at least 3 confirmed entries.

Class Descriptions

TWH Pleasure – Open to any flat shod horse without bands (country pleasure horses must abide by flatshod rules) Novice Trail Horse – Horse not to have won 3 blue ribbons in a Trail class at **any** affiliated show.

Novice – Horse and/or rider not to have won 3 blue ribbons at any affiliated show.

Equitation Division – Adult equitation classes are open to any adult rider and will not require a solid equitation suit. AOT – Amateur Owned and Trained.

Limit – Not to have won 6 blue ribbons at any affiliated show.

Ribbons won in one-horse horse classes do not count in reckoning the Novice or limit status of either horse and/or exhibitor in any division. Therefore, classes with only one entry do not count in regard to the number of blue ribbons won in relation to the status of Novice or Limit classes.

USDA Rules

All Tennessee Walking Horses are required to go through DQP inspection.

- 1. All horses presented for DQP inspection must have saddles removed and braces off prior to being inspected. Additionally, all winners must unsaddle & remove braces prior to post-show inspection. There will be a designated tack area near the DQP station. Please bring a marked saddle rack with you. For the safety of all exhibitors, saddle racks will only be allowed in the designated tack area.
- 2. If exhibitors plan to stay in the warm up area for more than one class, they must check in with the DQP Secretary prior to each class.
- 3. No chains or action devices are allowed to be used on any flat shod horses or horses that will be shown in any flat shod class at the show.
- 4. Only three people per horse will be allowed in the DQP station; the rider, trainer & one handler. This will be strictly enforced for the safety all horses & individuals.
- 5. If you are excused by the DQP for any reason other than having an unruly horse, you will be disqualified for the remainder of the show. No refunds will be given by WIWHA.
- 6. Horses dismissed from the show arena, either by a judge, steward or rider of the horse must report directly to the inspection area for follow up inspection.

Facility Rules

Hotal Information - Vancouver WA

- 1. Smoking is permitted in designated areas only. All buildings and arenas are designated as "NO SMOKING". Any fees charged to WIWHA Show & Futurity resulting from a violation of this rule will be billed directly to the person at fault, along with a \$100 fine.
- 2. All dogs must be kept on a leash or in a pen near your RV. Dogs left in stalls may not be locked.
- 3. All children must be supervised. Children are not allowed to run loose in the show arena/grandstands.
- 4. Please clean up all messes left by your dogs and horses. Pick up all garbage and place in garbage cans.
- 5. You must leave the facility in the same condition as you found it. Shavings and/or landscape materials used outside your barn area must be removed and the area swept clean. All such charges incurred by WIWHA Show & Futurity will be passed on to the individual(s) responsible. Vandalism, damage or displacement of Clark County Fairgrounds property or the property of any trainer, owner or exhibitor will result in a \$50.00 fine to all individuals involved in addition to any charges for damages.
